

# Electric Rate Changes Coming Oct. 1 —With Offset from Power Cost Adjustment

At Idaho Falls Power, our mission remains steady: deliver reliable, affordable electricity to our community. As a not-for-profit municipal utility, we're proud to operate one of the lowest-cost utilities in Idaho and the entire country—without shareholder profits or taxpayer funding. Each year, we evaluate our operations, infrastructure needs, and rising material costs to ensure long-term sustainability. As part of that process, the Idaho Falls City Council approved modest adjustments to electric rates, effective October 1, 2025.

For residential customers, the monthly service charge will increase by \$1.00, and the base energy rate will move from 7.15¢ to 7.60¢ per kilowatt-hour. However, this increase is largely offset by a Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) of -0.50¢/kWh, reducing the net effective rate to 7.10¢. The result? A typical residential customer using 800 kWh per month will see only a \$0.60 increase on their monthly bill. Commercial and industrial customers will see similar minimal changes or, in some cases, a decrease due to the PCA.

The PCA allows us to pass savings associated with wholesale power fluctuations directly to customers. This year, thanks to efficient hydropower production and strategic energy purchases the PCA will reduce the overall impact on your monthly bill.

Idaho Falls Power rates remain well below state and national averages. Our commitment to maintaining low costs, high reliability, and local accountability drives every decision we make. We're also investing in system upgrades, renewable energy, and customer programs

that help you save energy and money. We appreciate your trust and partnership as we continue powering our community together.

# New Interactive Hydropower Exhibit at Heritage Park

Idaho Falls Power, in collaboration with INL and the U.S. Department of Energy, has unveiled a new interactive hydropower exhibit at Heritage Park. Nicknamed "The Little Lower," the hands-on model replicates the historic Old Lower Power Plant and lets visitors control water flow to see how hydropower works.

Designed and built with help from BYU-Idaho students, the exhibit blends history, science, and community. Located near the original plant site, it's a tribute to the clean, renewable hydropower that still supplies about one-third of Idaho Falls' energy.

Directions: From U.S. Highway 91, head west on Canyon Road (97th South). Look for signs for the boat launch and Gem State Fishing Pond. Turn north onto the unpaved road and follow it for about 1 mile to the parking lot and ramp.
