Looking Ahead: *FERC timeline for providing feedback on the Updated Study Report*

- IFP will file a meeting summary with FERC with 15 days (by July 8, 2026)
 - Participants will have 30 days from that filing date (until August 11, 2026) to file any disagreements/requests to amend the study plan
 - IFP will response to disagreements/requests within 30 days (by September 10, 2026)
 - FERC will issue a determination within 30 days (by October 10, 2026)
- IFP will file the Draft License Application (DLA) by September 2, 2026
 - Participants will have until December 2, 2026 to file comments on the DLA
- IFP will file the Final License Application (FLA) by January 31, 2027
